Outside there is ample parking on the driveway, for at least 6 cars, which leads to a new double garage (18ft x 16ft). There are gardens on all 4 sides, with some lovely hidden aspects, to sit and take in the peace and tranquility of the lovely surroundings. There is a summerhouse, greenhouse large workshop/studio 18ft x 10ft


